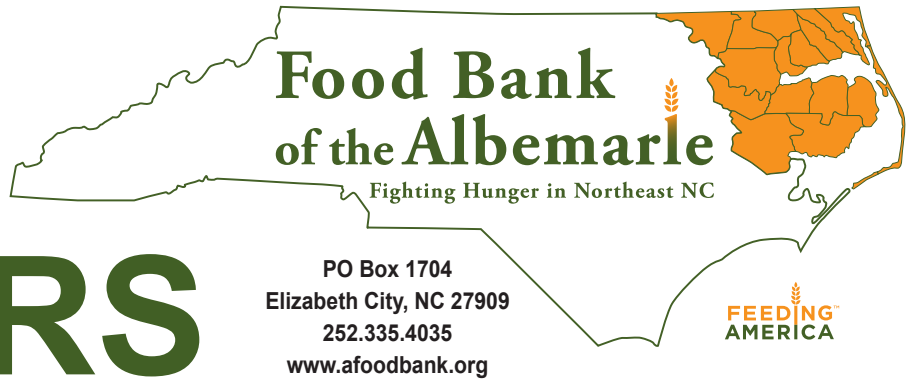


# OUR IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS



## OUR NUMBERS

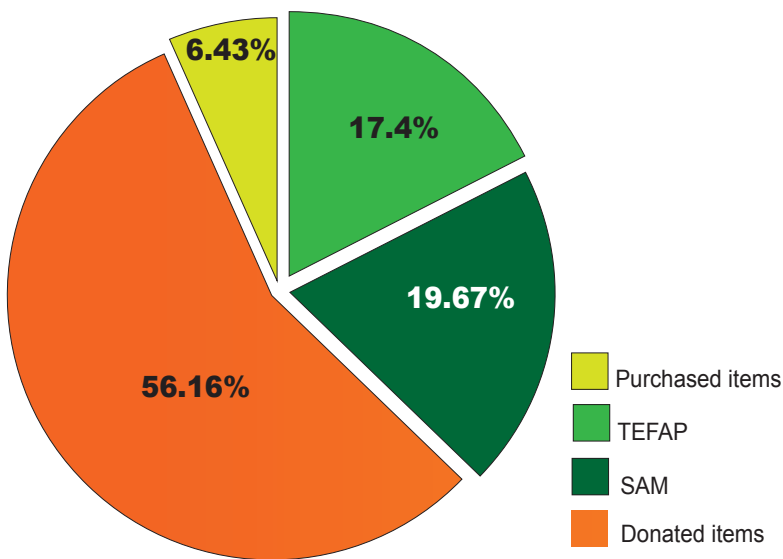
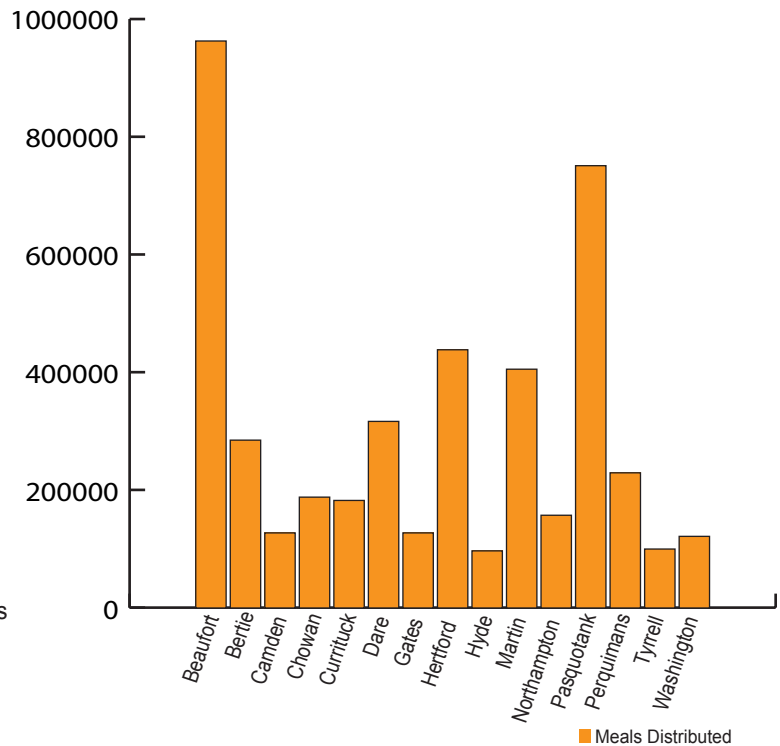
- 13** board members govern the organization
- 18** full and part-time staff members
- 7** inmates provide assistance in our warehouse while receiving work skills.
- 1,434** volunteers gave more than 10,348 hours helping us achieve our mission
- 20,000 SQ. FT.** warehouse space plus walk-in cooler and freezer, to store large donations that will feed the hungry in 15 counties.
- 21** deployments of our Mobile Food Pantry go out each month.
- 389** unique food and grocery donors.
- 112 HUNGER RELIEF PARTNERS** operating 147 unique programs working in tandem with the food bank to provide food for people in need.
- 4** meals can be provided for each donated dollar.
- \$0.97** of every dollar funds our feeding programs.
- 4 STAR RATING** was given to the Food Bank of the Albemarle by Charity Navigator for our accountability and transparent practices.

## MEALS PROVIDED by COUNTY



In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, gender identity (including gender expression), sexual orientation, disability, age, marital status, family/parental status, income derived from a public assistance program, political beliefs, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity, in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA (not all bases apply to all programs).
