






## **OUR NUMBERS**

- 13 board members govern the organization.
- **36** full and part-time staff members.
- **3,233** volunteers gave more than **8,659 hours** helping us achieve our mission.
- **27,500 SQ. FT.** warehouse space plus **80,000 cu. ft**. walk-in cooler and freezer, to store large donations that will feed the hungry in 15 counties.
- **28** deployments of our Mobile Food Pantry go out each month.
- **192** unique food and grocery donors.
- **100 HUNGER RELIEF PARTNERS** operating 140 unique programs working in tandem with the food bank to provide food for people in need.
- 4 meals can be provided for each donated dollar.
- 97% of every donation supports our hunger-relief programs
