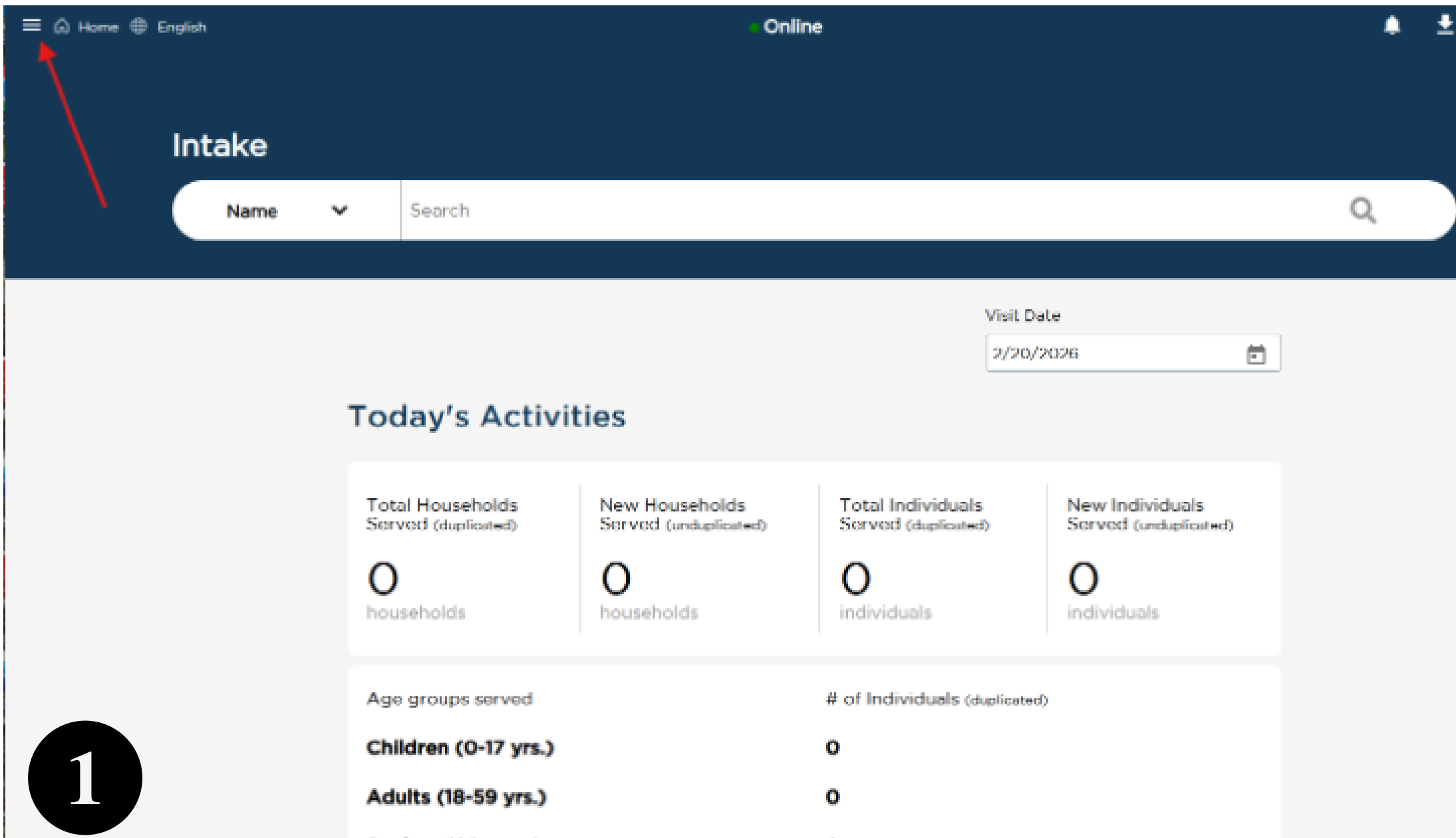

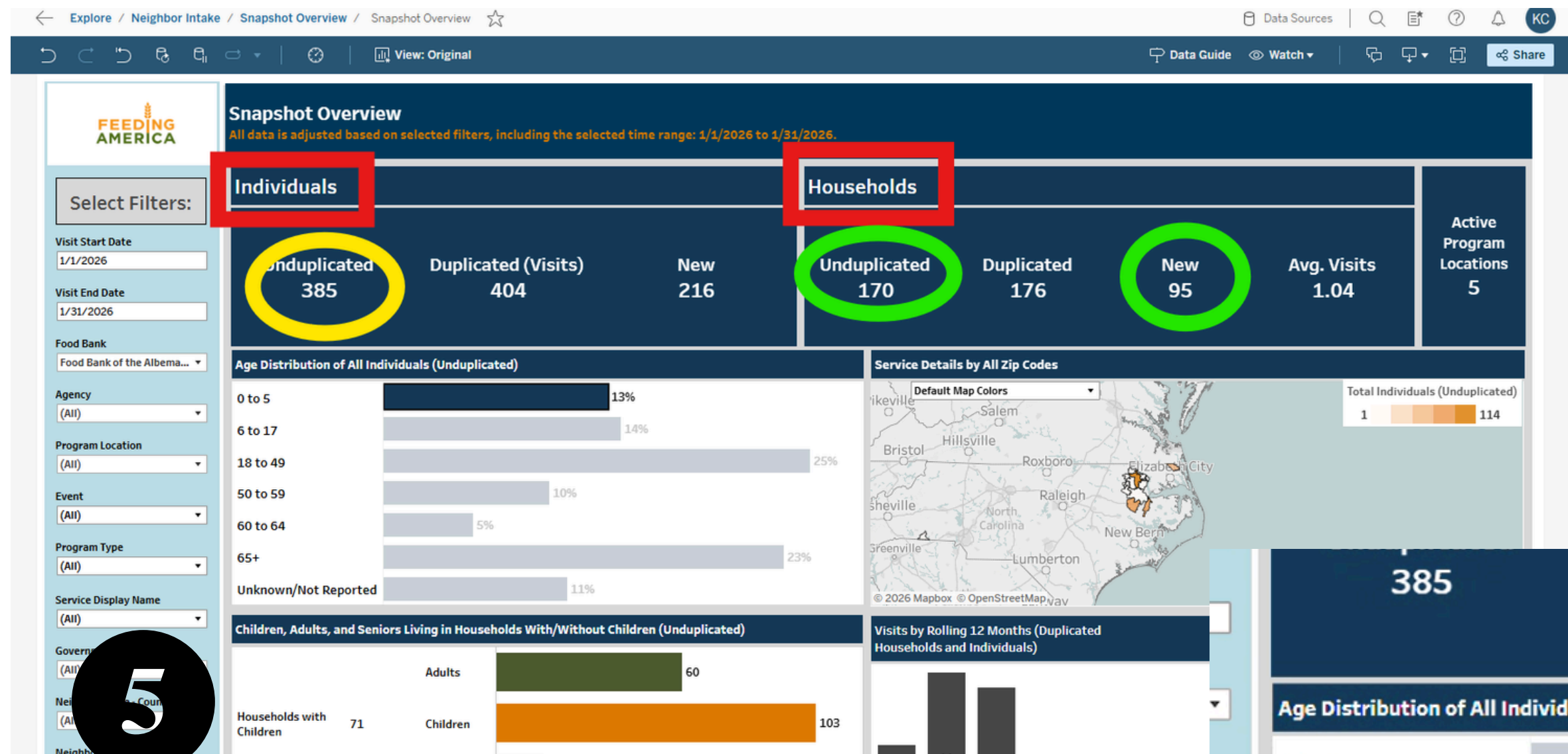
Map showing service locations in North Carolina. Total Individuals (Unduplicated): 114.

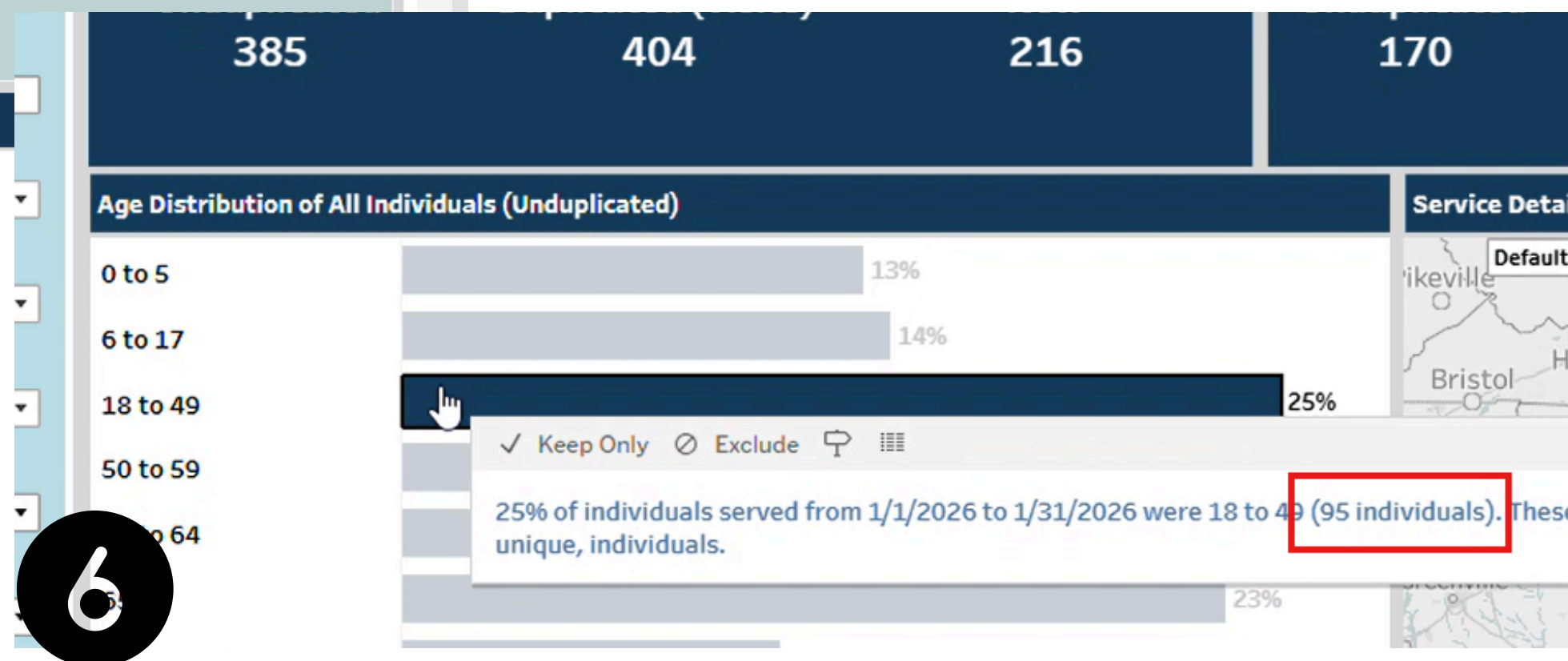
